

The Ohio House of Representatives is currently working on the state budget for the next two years. The House Finance Committee accepted an amendment that eliminates the Public Library Fund and replaces it with a line-item appropriation, representing a \$100 million cut to library funding compared to Governor DeWine's budget.
